

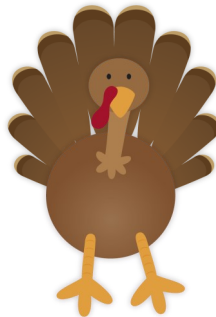
# November Preschool Press
