Easy Holiday Recipes to do With Kids

Christmas Pretzel Hugs



Ingredients:

- 1 bag square pretzels
- 2 bags Chocolate Kisses
- 1 bag M&M Chocolate Candies

Instructions:

1. Preheat oven to 200 degrees
2. Add parchment paper or silicone baking mat to a large cookie sheet
3. Add pretzels
4. Unwrap and add chocolate kisses
5. Bake for 4-5 minutes or until chocolate kisses are shiny and melted enough to add the M&M's
6. Remove from oven and immediately add M&M's, push down gently
7. Place in refrigerator to chill 10-15 minutes or until set.

Christmas Pretzel Rods



Ingredients:

- A bag of white chocolate chips
- A bag of pretzel rods
- Christmas sprinkles

You'll also need:

- Glass measuring bowl or mixing bowl for melting chocolates.
- A spoon for stirring
- Parchment Paper or Wax Paper

Instructions:

1. Melt chocolate in a glass bowl in the microwave.
2. Do this in 20 second increments. Stir between. Should take about 1 minute to fully melt. If it takes longer, shorten increments to 10 seconds to prevent burning.
3. Once chocolate is melted, dip pretzel into it, coating 1/2 to 3/4 of the pretzel in chocolate. You can use a spoon to scoop chocolate and spread evenly around.
4. Lay the pretzel on the parchment paper and coat all sides with sprinkles. Let harden for about 10 minutes. Enjoy!
